Not Retuning in 2019?

Every fortnight, Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) is part of our Gemstone Learning Team meetings. This is a time where students discuss areas of concern that need to be focused on to ensure our school's wide expectations and school rules of being safe, being respectful and being an active learner, are followed.

This fortnight, our focus is on:

If your child has lost a drink bottle, lunch box or an item of clothing, please ensure you check Lost Property.



It is important that all items of clothing, lunch boxes etc are labelled so that they can be returned to your child if they are found in the playground.

These belongings are expensive and it is a shame when we are not able to return them to their rightful owner.

Items unclaimed for more than a fortnight and unlabelled clothing items are sent to the uniform shop for resale, other items are sadly disposed of.

Parking Near the School

When dropping off or picking up your child, please ensure you park in the appropriate streets surrounding the school. Take note to comply with the 'No Stopping' and 'Bus Zones' along Nelson Ave.

There is a 'Kiss and Drop' zone outside the school. In this area, drivers may stop to drop off or pick up children however, 'No Parking' rules apply.

- Maximum stop time is 2 minutes.
- Driver must remain in or within 3 metres of their vehicle.
- Vehicles must not be left unattended.

The police and rangers patrol around the school regularly. Fines can be quite expensive for parking illegally around a school.

Opal Card 2019

The School Student Transport scheme can provide free travel on trains and buses to and from school for eligible students.
