I understand and use the sandpit timetable

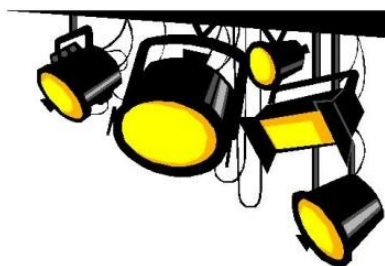

There is NO adult supervision at our school before 8:30 am and after 3:15 pm.

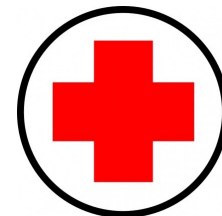
We understand that many parents have work duties but ask families make arrangements with extended family, friends or neighbours for the supervision of your child/ children outside of school hours.

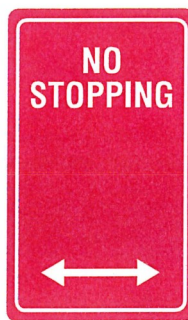

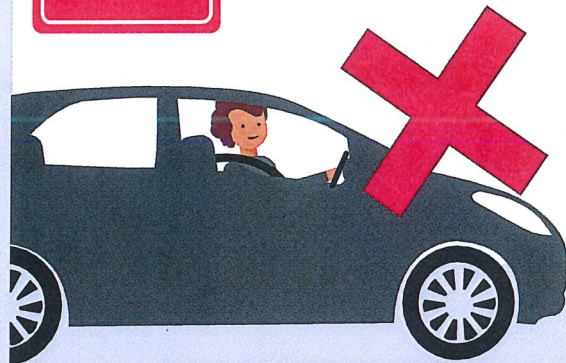
